#### **MPSSAA TENNIS BULLETIN**

State Championships - May 24-25, 2013 University of Maryland - College Park

#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. The Maryland Public Secondary Schools Athletic Association is the official governing body for the Tennis tournament. Plans for the tournament were formulated by the State Tennis Committee and approved by the Board of Control.
- B. Schools choosing to enter the tournament have the responsibility for reading and adhering to the rules and regulations stated in the front section of this publication as well as those appearing within this Tennis Bulletin.
- C. Eligibility rules for all participants are defined in MPSSAA Bylaw .02, found in the current MPSSAA Handbook.
- D. General regulations for all state tournaments are contained in MPSSAA Bylaw .07, found in both the current Handbook and in the front section of this publication.
- E. Officials are performing a disservice to the sport and to the competitors when they allow unsports-manlike acts to go uncalled because they do not want to appear to be "too picky" or that they feel that a regular season competition is not a "major match". As a result when those athletes do participate in a major competition (such as at the regional or state tournment level) and the rules are enforced according to the code, players then think that the rules are unfair or that they should have received a warning, etc. since "no one had made that call during the regular season".

All too often, parents, coaches, and the media argue that the rules are inconsistently applied and that officials do not consider how devastating it is to disqulify an athlete during a major meet for an unsportsmanlike action such as a thrown racket or other similar offense. Certainly, this should not happen. Although such disqualifications are ultimately the responsibility of the athlete and coach, meet officials who have tolerated those illegal actions during the regular season also must assume some of the responsibility.

# **II. REGION AND STATE TOURNAMENTS**

# A. General Policies

- 1. Players must wear school-issued or school-approved proper tennis attire or the official tournament T-shirt in all matches. **Uniforms must cover a player's midriff when standing. PENALTY: default.** 
  - a. Proper attire includes an unaltered shirt with a school name or logo. Uniform bottoms should be neat and appropriate to the tennis setting. Uniforms must cover a player's midriff when standing.
  - b. Dressing facilities will be available at the state tournament site.

- 2. It is mandatory that contestants are accompanied to the tournament by the official coach or an authorized school representative.
  - a. A letter of authorization on official letterhead signed by the principal, athletic director or school system designated representative must be presented.
  - b. There shall be a limit of two coaches per school.
  - c. Penalty: default.
- 3. Coaching is permissible during the 90 second changeover period as long as it does not interfere with continuous play (USTA Rule-29 regarding Continuous Play). Coaching is limited to the high school coach. A coach will NOT be permitted on the courts except in case of injury.
- 4. The Tennis Committee considers entry on the draw sheet as the start of play. Participants who withdraw after such entry are subject to penalties under MPSSAA Bylaw .07C(11).

### B. Playing Rules

- 1. Play will be by USTA rules, except where noted.
- 2. Any player found guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct during tournament play will be penalized according to the following point penalty system:
  - a. Tardiness penalties (assessed by the Site Director: refer to current "Friend at Court.")
    - (1) One game for each five minutes or fraction thereof that contestant(s) is late.
    - (2) Forfeit by contestant(s) arriving 15 minutes after the official calling of the match.
  - b. Failure to commence play after expiration of established warm-up period:

```
1st offense - Warning
2nd offense - one point
```

c. Violation of Rule 30 (continuousness of play)

```
1st offense - Warning
2nd & subsequent offenses - one point
```

d. Unsportsmanlike acts

```
1st offense - one point
2nd offense - Disqualification
```

e. Profane, threatening or obscene language, gestures, or taunting

```
1st offense - one point
2nd offense - Disqualification
```

3. If a penalty point has been assessed due to an infraction of 2.d or 2.e above, a subsequent infraction of 2.d or 2.e will result in disqualification.

NOTE: All penalty points will be assessed by a tournament official including committee members. Warnings and penalty points will be recorded immediately at the scorer's table.

4. USTA guidelines will be employed in case of extreme heat conditions.

#### III. REGION TOURNAMENT

- A. Tournament Organization
  - 1. Each tournament shall be set up on a similar basis with no player allowed to participate in more than one event.
  - 2. Each region tournament director should submit the full name, grade, the school represented, season record, and coach's name for each Region winner through 4th place to Russell Maxwell (W) 301-918-8600; Fax -301-918-8606; (H) 410-672-5473.

The region tournament director must send entries by email to russell.maxwell@pgcps.org by noon on Monday, May 20.

3. Each region will submit two entries/teams to the state tournament in each of the following categories, for a total of 16 different players:

Boys singles
Boys doubles teams
Mixed doubles teams
Girls singles
Girls doubles teams

- a. Doubles teams must be composed of players from the same school.
- b. If either player on a doubles team is unable to compete, that entry is disqualified.
- c. The next alternate team **from the same region** will fill the position.
- 4. The region champion will receive a team plaque and individual certificates.

#### **IV. STATE TOURNAMENT**

- A. Tournament Organization
  - 1. The seeding committee will meet at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, May 21, at the Howard H.S.
  - 2. If any player is unable to attend the tournament, the region may send an alternate. Alternates will be selected according to their final standings in region competition. Therefore, each region shall determine third and fourth places. In the event an entered player cannot participate, it is the responsibility of that player's coach to contact the region director by 6 p.m. of the day before the first round of the state tournament so that an alternate may be notified. Region directors must inform the state committee director by 10 p.m. of the substitution.
  - 3. The 2013 tournament will be held at the University of Maryland College Park campus on May 24-25. Please refer to the Fan Focus on MPSSAA.org.

#### Directions to the University of Maryland Cole Field House Courts

**From I-95/I-495 (Capital Beltway):** Exit Route 1 South. Go one mile and bear right onto MD. Rte. 193 West (University Blvd.) - Go to second light; turn left on Stadium Drive. Bear right on Valley Drive at 1st traffic circle. Go beyond construction on left. Tennis courts will be to the left next to Cole field House. Please adhere to all campus parking regulations.

#### 4. Schedule

- a. Friday, May 24 10 a.m. (Two preliminary rounds)
- b. Saturday, May 25 10 a.m. (Semifinals); 1 p.m. (Consolations and Finals: weather permitting)
- 5. The format shall be single elimination (two out of three 6-game sets with a 7-point tiebreaker at 6 games all). A five minute break between the second and third set will be allowed, if requested.
- 6. Players and coaches are to report to the tennis courts by 9:30 a.m. on Friday, May 24. Adjustments in starting times may be made at the meeting of the seeding committee.
- 7. In the event of a postponement, the state tournament committee reserves the right to modify play or cancel for the day.
  - a. In the event of a postponement and indoor courts are unavailable, all Friday matches will be played on Saturday. If it is raining Saturday and indoor courts are unavailable, play will begin at 9 a.m. on Monday, May 27.
  - b. If additional matches are required, play shall begin at 9 a.m. the next day, weather permitting.
- 8. USTA officials will be on site.

#### B. General Policies

- 1. USTA-approved Wilson tennis balls will be used.
- 2. Singles sticks will be used in all singles matches.
- 3. Awards will be presented following the finals for 1st through 4th place in each category. In addition, a Region Tennis Champion will be declared. Points are awarded for each category in the following manner:

**6 points**—Champion **3 points**—3rd Place **1 point**—Quarterfinalist **4 points**—Finalist **2 points**—4th Place
