**OTHER INDIVIDUAL DEFENSIVE STATS**  
 The Hurricanes defense forced 31 total turnovers this season including 22 interceptions and 9 recovered fumbles. This defense has shutout 5 opponents allowing 89 (8 ppg) total points through the State Semifinals.

**OTHER INDIVIDUAL OFFENSIVE STATS**  
 The Hurricanes offense has been very productive scoring 356 pts (32 ppg) with two RBs rushing for 600+ yds each and 21 total TDs. Jr QB Dominic Hickman has passed for 900 yds while rushing for almost 400 yds and 7 TDs. Jr Brody Whittington has rushed for nearly 600 yds and received for 300+ yds.

 (Sr-WR) Trevor Robbins, (Sr-WR) Trent Depompa and (Jr-RB) Gabriel Copeland on offense. In the State Semifinal win over Milford Mill (24-16), (Jr-WR/S) Brody Whittington dominated the game rushing for 250 yds and 1 TD, 3 kickoff returns for nearly 90 yds, 10 tackles and 1 interception returning it for 80 yds. The offensive line will start 5 seniors.  
 The Hurricanes use a multiple front defense led by (Sr-DE) Evan Powell, a West Virginia verbal commit, (Sr-DE) Keith Bell and (Sr-NG) Liam Murray. All four linebackers are statistical leaders in tackles. (Jr-Safety) Brody Whittington leads the team with interceptions (3) while Trevor Robbins, Brayden Brooks and Matt Friel have two each. Nine other Hurricanes have one interception. (Sr-DE) Keith Bell blocked a punt and recovered it for a TD in the Regional Finals win.  
 In the State Semifinals win over Miford Mill, the Hurricanes defense caused 5 turnovers (4 interceptions and a fumble recovery).  
 The Huntingtown Hurricanes football program led by Head Coach Paul Friel has made 5 of the last 6 State Semifinals and two straight State Championship games.  
 The back to back Championship game appearances in Football is a first for any Calvert County High School.  
 The Hurricanes have split two playoff meetings with Stephen Decatur, winning the 2021 Regional Final 28-14 and losing the 2023 State Final 21-13.
